YOU MUST WRITE YOUR OWN LETTER, DO NOT SIGN THIS

Dear Father Kris,

As I finish my preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, I ask you to accept me as a Confirmation candidate.

Tell about yourself, here are some examples...

Write about your family, where you live, where you go to school, your favorite sport or activity, or anything else that makes you unique.

Tell him about the Work Crew reflections you did, how you felt, who you served, and what difference you made in the lives of those you served.

Tell about something NEW that you learned about the Catholic Church this past year and how it affected your faith life.

Tell him your Confirmation name and why you chose it. What did you learn about the saint and how does his/her example affect your faith life?

Tell about the person you chose as a sponsor and why you chose him/her. How does this person influence your faith life?

Tell Father Kris anything else that you would like him to know about you.
